Wir wollen mit Musiktheater gesellschaftspolitische relevante Themen und Fragen wie Stadtentwicklung, Migration, Mittelstands-Armut, Einsamkeit des Alterns, u.a. verhandeln. Themen sind der Kern der (Kunst)-Arbeit. Sie sind das WARUM, Musiktheater ist das WAS, Zeitgenössisch das WIE. Wir möchten vermehrt junge Menschen fürs Musiktheater begeistern. Deshalb bieten wir kostenfreien Eintritt für alle unter 25. Wir wollen zeigen, dass (Musik)-Theater außerhalb ihrer 'Tempel' dem Publikum andere Sinneseindrücke liefert. Wir sind um eine höhere Sichtbarkeit von zeitgenössischen Musiktheater-Stücken im österreichischen Kunstsektor bemüht und ebenso um eine verstärkte internationale Präsenz unserer Arbeiten, ermöglicht durch Koproduktionen und ein internationales Netzwerk.






